Instructions: As you take the inventory respond relatively quickly. Do not over-analyze the questions. Circle each number honestly using the numbers below.

1= never true / 2=almost never/ 3=rarely/ 4=sometimes / 5=usually/ 6=almost always/ 7=always true

How to do the scoring:

Sample example of A.) using two numbers:

1a.) I think God exists

How to do scoring for Next Month Section

Note: This time you are looking for the amount of change. If a number moves to the right you add a positive number. If the number moves to the left you have a negative number.

Sample example of A.) using two numbers

1a.) I think God exists

Note: The first month number for 1a.) was 6. The next month number for 1a.) was 5. Since the number moved to the left you have a -1.

The first month number for 2a.) was 5. The next month number for 2a.) was 6. Since the number moved to the right you have +1.

Scoring

Next Month **A.) Add up the sum of the change of 35a.** _____
 B.) Add up the sum of the change of 35b. _____
 D.) Add A.) and B.) to the first baseline
 for the new baseline _____ ← **new baseline**

So for the two numbers given for A.) you add -1 to +1 and you get 0. You then do the same thing for 1a through 35a and enter the amount on the line of A.)

Do the same for B.)

Then simply add A.) and B.) to the first baseline.

Sample:

Next Month **A.) Add up the sum of the change of 35a.** +4
 B.) Add up the sum of the change of 35b. +5
 E.) Add A.) and B.) to the first baseline $57 + 9 = 66$
 for the new baseline 66 ← **new baseline**

What do the numbers mean?

The numbers do not have intrinsic meaning when standing alone. The first sum is designed to become the baseline from which you can measure the faith growth.

Why do I subtract 35b from 35a in the first month?

Faith is more than convictions. Faith is also about hope, well-grounded expectations. (See Heb 11:1) 35a is about conviction. 35b is about hope. We tend to have greater conviction than hope. The less the hope the more anemic is our faith, even with strong conviction. Our goal is to grow in both A.) and B.) The First Month baseline reflects these thoughts.

Why do I add the amount of change to the first month baseline? Once you have the baseline you want to track the movement from the baseline. Am I growing? Am I decreasing? Why? What do I learn from looking over the change of numbers?

Repeat this survey again. Use the New baseline as your new starting point and repeat.

A.) Add up the sum of the change of 35a. _____

Important note about this inventory. 1.) *If you only do this inventory once the sum will not tell you anything significant.* 2.) *The second numbers from the second taking of the inventory should be compared to the first numbers (not to other people's numbers.) Therefore, the important numbers to watch are the change of numbers.* 3.) *These numbers are for you and you alone. Comparing them to others will not be helpful.*

Pray about the numbers you see. Choose five numbers to regularly pray about in the following month. Do you want certain numbers to grow? Ask Jesus to help you find a way to grow that area.

Repeat this process over a course of time. Come back to it after a break. Continue the process. Continue to ask the questions above. As you look at the movement develop a plan how to address the numbers the Holy Spirit prods you to examine and work on.
